

Movies of Valley Babies Featured

Rogue River valley babies are to have an opportunity to "go into the movies" according to a statement made by the Rialto theatre, in announcing a motion picture baby contest to be conducted by the theatre. Actual movies of all valley youngsters under five years of age will be taken free of charge starting next Wednesday. Arrangements have been made to send a cameraman to Medford to take motion picture equipment and studio lights to take the pictures.

Every mother residing in the valley is invited to enter her child or children in the baby contest and bring them to the Rialto theatre this Wednesday morning between 9:30 and 11:30 o'clock to have the pictures taken. These films will later be shown on the Rialto screen each Tuesday for a period of eight weeks starting December 8.

Duck and Goose Hunting Improving

Duck hunting is somewhat improved on Upper Klamath Lake over last weekend. Warmer weather has thawed some of the ice and there is more open water. Geese are quite numerous and are feeding in the swamp around the lake, making shooting very good. The grass and tules in the swamp are still very dry, and hunters should be careful about fires. Several fires have already been started in the swamp, and timber around the swamp. One of these burned over about 1000 acres of feeding and nesting grounds for ducks and geese.
