

Time of Drivers' Licenses Extended

Oregon driver's licenses, issued on or after June 15, 1941, need not be renewed this year, Secretary of State Robert S. Farrell said today. The 1945 legislature assembly extended the time of these licenses to June 30, 1947.

The numbers of all licenses thus extended bear the prefix "5R", Farrell said.

"Many drivers apparently believe they are required to renew their driver's licenses this year, but the act of the 1945 legislature extends the time these licenses are valid through the next two years," Farrell said.

The secretary of state explained it is not necessary that a new license card be obtained, showing the new expiration date. All enforcement authorities throughout the nation have been notified of the legislature's

SCHOOL VACATION

The closing of school to many children means days of freedom to enjoy out-of-door play and an opportunity to build health for another year; days free from a letting-down of the health rules practised so diligently through the school months.

Children's need for sleep and rest and proper food may be even greater during vacation days with the extra hours of play and warmer weather than during school days. Meals during the summer, as at all times, should be built around the protective foods—milk, fruits, vegetables and eggs. Three well-balanced meals served regularly each day from now through the summer will help to build health step by step. So it is important to continue to provide every day, adequate amounts of those foods which promote growth and increase general health as well as enough in amounts to care for the

greater energy needs during the summer months.

This year will see more and more young people helping with chores, with gardening, with the harvest, and many other jobs that will help in the war effort. Emphasis has been placed on the importance of the right foods every day for working people so that health and efficiency are maintained. The right foods are doubly important for these younger workers since their foods must provide for growth in addition to maintaining health and energy.

During these vacation days keep the food habits under control if you expect your children to return to school in the fall definitely benefited from the summer vacation months. Your summertime guide should include two or more glasses of milk daily for adults—three to four or more daily for children—to drink and combined with other foods.

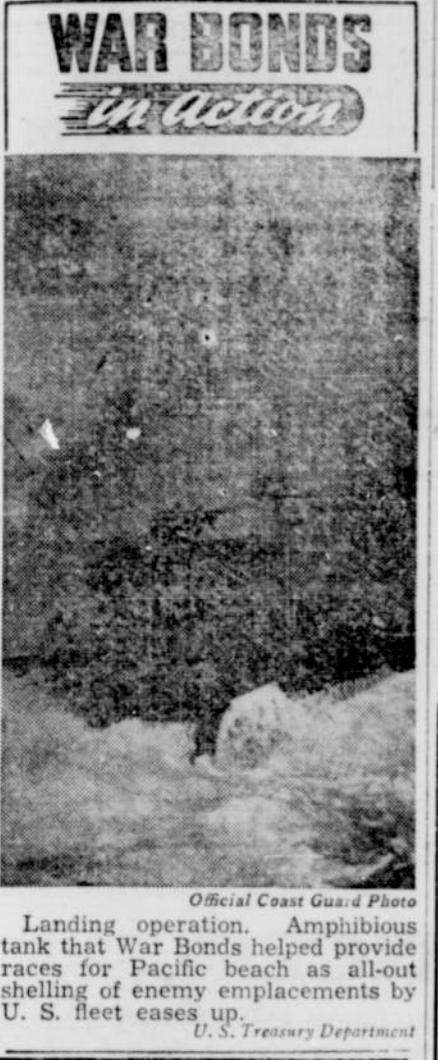
Surplus Truck Sales to Farmers Mad by Areas

Preliminary steps to obtain more government surplus trucks for Oregon farmers under a new sales plan have been started, with first action affecting the principal wheat-growing counties, N. C. Donaldson, executive assistant of the state AAA committee has announced.

The new program provides for sales of allocated trucks to dealers who agree to resell to farmers and farmer cooperative within designated areas. Farmers who hold AAA certificates can then purchase trucks direct.

However, if the license card has become mutilated, or the driver wishes a new card showing a change of address or personal description, he may make application to the secretary of state for a duplicate card which will be issued for a fee of 25 cents. Farrell emphasized, however, that drivers are not required by law to obtain a new card to show a change of address, a change in personal description, or to show the new expiration date.
