## Bathroom Plans Can Make Homes More Convenient

In planning that new postwar farm home pay more attention to getting a convenient bathroom, suggests Lois A. Lutz, home management specialist in the O.S.C. Extension service. Many of the labor and space saving ideas common in the kitchen can also be applied to this important room, she says.

Though the bathroom is one of the most expensive rooms in this house because of the cost of plumbing fixtures, most of them are designed simply to hold the three traditional units without much attention to convenience," she explains. Floor and wall space can just as well be used for cupboards, and working counters as wasted. The space under the washbowl, for example, can be made into a cupboard for cleaning supplies just as the space under the sink is used in well planned kitchens.

In a house having only one bathroom for the whole family, this room may be arranged for the use of more

than one person at a time. For example, partitions or curtains may be installed around the different units so that children may use them while father shaves—a saving of much time and confusion at the rush hour in the morning when the family is getting ready for school and work.

Much upper wall space could be put into roomy cupboards to hold towels and bathing and dressing supplies, Miss Lutz adds. Lower wall

space might hold a built-in bench for dressing, or the opening to a bin for soiled clothes. Counters on either side of the wash bowl may be as much of a convenience as counters on either side of the sink in the kitchen. These may be useful for bathing the baby, doing hand laundry, or holding shaving and dressing supplies. Even the ceiling may be put to use. A folding rack to hold laundry, attached to the ceiling, will prevent draping wet stockings and other clothing over towel racks and shower bars.
