U.S. National Bank Makes Record Gains in Deposits

It is with a great deal of satisfaction that Geo. T. Frey, manager of the Medford branch of the United States National Bank, announces record-breaking gains in both deposits and resources.

In its statement of condition, required by the Comptroller of the

Currency's official call of December 31, 1945, the United States National Bank reported deposits of \$581,111,238.52 and resources of \$607,046,414.19.

Not only do these deposits represent another all-time high but, in addition, they reveal a gain of \$100,302,280.66 over the corresponding call date of a year ago. Resources for the twelve-month period gained \$196,544,400.36. Another substantial gain for the same interval was made in loans and discounts. The total figure was \$68,940,887.33 as against \$41,894,023.17 or an increase of \$27,046,864.16.

"This is a record," stated Mr. Frey, "of which we are justly proud. It proves anew that the United States National is truly an Oregon bank serving Oregon."

Liberated Missionary Speaks at Eagle Point

The Landis, a liberated missionary who will be at the Community church in Eagle Point, spent 12 years in the Philippine Islands ministering among the Mohammedan Moro tribes in Sulu. Taught one year in the Ebenezer Bible Institute in Zamboanga Mindanao. They hid in the mountain jungles of Mindanao for over a year after Pearl Harbor day evading the Japanese army. Lived a very primitive but free life that year.

In Jan. 1943 they were captured by a Japanese squad and imprisoned. They spent 25 months in 4 Japanese concentration camps among them, Santa Tomas and Los Banos. They all suffered severely from malnutrition, but while several hundred fellow-internees perished they survived. Roots, weeds, dogs, cats, slugs and Japanese garbage were all eaten by American and British internees. Finally they were rescued on Feb. 23, 1945 by U.S. Army Airborne troops and an amphibian balter battalion on the very morning of the day the Japanese were going to slaughter the entire camp. Finally they returned to the United States on Army transport.

Arriving at San Pedro, Calif. on May 2. They expect to go back to their chosen field of work as soon as it is possible.

Rev. Landis To Speak At Federated Church

Rev. Roderic M. Landis, who was interned in four different camps in remote mountain regions of the Philippines during which time they lived a very primitive life. They were interned in the Zamboanga, Santo Tomas, Davao and Los Banos camps for a total of 25 months.

They were in Los Banos camp on February 23, 1945, when United States army airborne troops and amphibious tractor corps daringly penetrated 25 miles beyond Japanese the Philippines by the Japanese will be the guest speaker at the Federated Church Sunday at 11 A.M. and also at 7:45 P.M. Mr. and Mrs. Landis with their three children were captured by the Japanese in January, 1943, after having successfully evaded them for a year by hiding in the lines to liberate the prisoners. Rev. Mr. Landis suffered from beri-beri but survived while many hundreds of his fellow-internees perished.
