Some of our industries have gotten back into normal production—and that includes agriculture. But larger mass production concerns that turned every facility over to the Government for war purposes have not been able to show anything like "normal" results—the principal reason having been labor strikes, and the failure to obtain steel, coal, lumber, metals, minerals, electrical and other essentials.

THE CO-OPS MARCH FORWARD

The Department of Agriculture announced that the Rural Electrification had approved loans totaling \$4,531,000 to 12 borrowers in 11 States. The funds will be used to finance construction of rural electric facilities, including 3,928 miles of distribution lines to serve 8,671 farms and other rural consumers.

FARM CREDIT AT YOUR LOCAL BANK

The Farm Security Administration is being discontinued and it will be succeeded by a new agency called the Farmers' Home Administration.

Under the new plan the Government is going to stand behind the local bankers and help them to make farm loans at low rates of interest. The whole proposition looks as though the Government is in effect insuring the private bankers.
