1st Lt. Richard G. Twyman has been appointed Adjutant of the 4th Base Complement Squadron, at France Field, Canal Zone. It was announced by Col. Robert Baseler, today.

Lt. Twyman entered the service in 1942, and was appointed a 2nd Lt. in the Army Air Force, after completing his Aviation Cadet Training at Phoenix, Arizona, in April 1945. After service at several Army Air Bases in the States, he was assigned to the Caribbean Air Command for duty at France Field, where he has served as Aircraft Engineering Officer since his arrival in July 1946.

Lt. Twyman is the son of Mr. and Mrs. H. H. Twyman of Alturas, California, and was born at San Luis Obispo, California.

He attended Salinas Junior College after graduating from Central Point High School, in Oregon, in 1940, and worked for the Coast Line Truck Service at Watsonville, California until called into the service.

Lt. Twyman was prominent in sports in school, winning letters in football, track and boxing, and was served as coach at the France Field Boxing Team during the recent Panama Canal Department Championship boxing tournament, which had one champion in the Light Heavy Weight division.

His wife, the former Aileen M. Berry, daughter of Mrs. Ida Berry of Central Point, Oregon and their child, Lynda Kay, is expected to join him at France Field shortly.

"Only Child" Takes More Time Than Whole Family

Modern mothers with small families have often wondered how pioneer women managed to care for their large broods. Now science has un-

covered the fact that "only children" sometimes take a greater share of their mothers' time than a family of brothers and sisters, reports Mrs. Erma H. Little, extension specialist in family relationships, O.S.C.

A recent study in Vermont showed that the mother with a single child spent from 4 to 35 hours per week in caring for that child, the time requirement varying according to the age of the child. If there were several children, the time required in caring for all of them varied according to the age of the youngest.

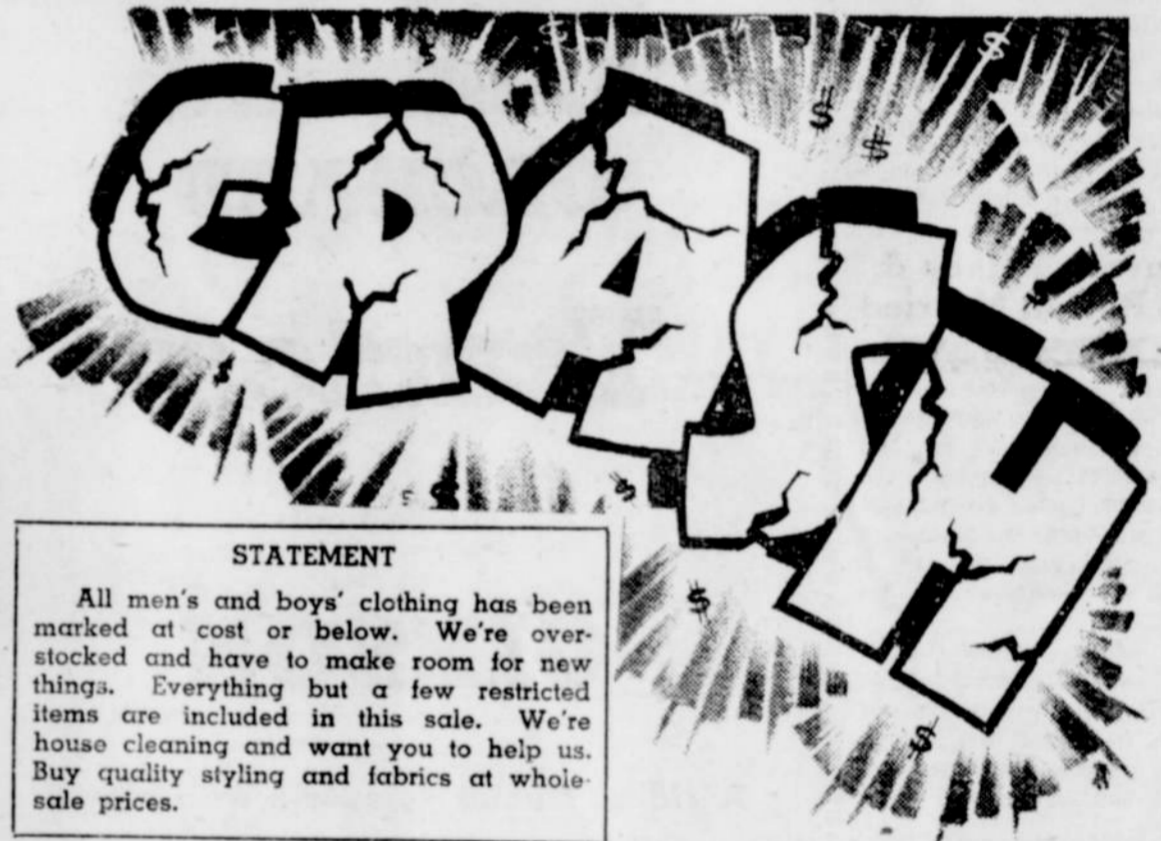
