they think that a bright yellow indicates a higher Vitamin A content.

Many people have also been led to falsely believe that the color wafer enclosed in each package of vitaminized margarine contains Vitamin A; however, the 150,000 units of Vitamin A contained in Best Foods' Nucoa and other leading margarines are mixed in the margarine itself. The color wafer is made of harmless vegetable matter, approved by the Pure Food and Drug Administration, and, incidentally, is the same coloring used in butter.

California Sales Tax Helps Schools

California schools have first call on Sales Tax Revenue in that state and have had since 1933, when the Act first was passed.

J. J. Campbell, Sales Tax Administrator, says that: "In 1933 when the law was first enacted, taxes on general property were very high and the delinquent rolls in many counties were reaching an alarming figure. The sales tax in California relieved general property of a great burden in

1933 and for several years thereafter."

"The sales tax collects a reasonable amount from those residents who pay no other taxes and particularly persons who may be in the State for a short period of time, foreigners, and local residents who own no property which is within the reach of the county assessor for tax purposes."

"In 1933 there was some attempt on the part of certain people to ridicule the so-called "penny" tax, however, this has died out long ago and the tax is accepted by the vast majority of people in this State as a proper adjunct to the tax system. In fact, over 50 cities in California have resorted to municipal sales taxes in order to replenish their local city treasuries due to the enormous expenditures required to take care of the influx of additional citizens who have come to this State to live."
