J. C. Rule Appointed New Bank Officer

J.C. "Rusty" Rule, one of the Northwest's pioneer installment credit loan executives, with nearly twenty years experience in the automobile and appliance field, has been elected assistant vice-president of the First National bank of Portland, announces Frank N. Belgrano, president.

Rule, who has served one company throughout his previous business career, in Spokane, Seattle, Butte and Portland, will join the installment credit loan department of First National bank July 1, and will have administrative duties in the department's business development and advisory service. Belgrano said that growth of this type of business since the close of the war makes Rule's addition to the staff extremely valuable to the bank.

After training in Seattle Rule opened branch offices in Spokane and in Butte for Universal C I T corporation, later returned to Seattle as branch manager. In 1937 he was appointed district manager for the Northwest, and two years later took the Southern half of the district when growth of the corporation required a split. Rule grew up in Missoula, and graduated from the University of Montana in 1927, earning the B. A. degree and majoring in business administration. He made his home in Portland since 1939.

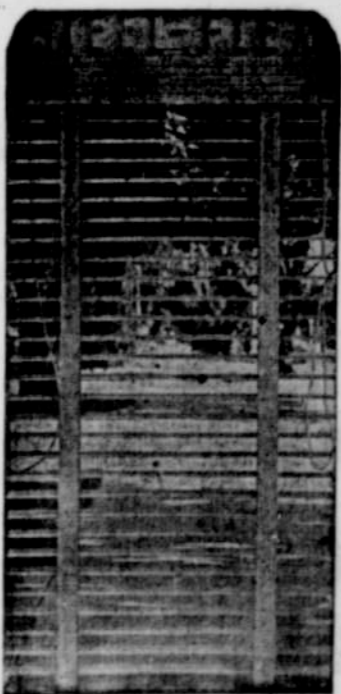
