Funeral services for James C. Gould, 30, Central Point, who passed away Sunday in Yreka, where he was visiting, was held in Conger-Morris chapel Wednesday at 10 a.m. with the Rev. M. E. Tisdell officiating. Committal services were in Siskiyou Memorial park.

Mr. Gould was born in Medford, March 5, 1920. He was a veteran of World War II, having served with the 1909th SVC Command Unit

from July 45, 1944 to May 6, 1946. At the time of his death he was employed as a locomotive engineer by the Medford corporation. On June 19, 1941, in Reno, Nevada, he was united in marriage to Miss Doris Currie.

Surviving are his widow, two children James and Charles; one brother, Albert, Klamath Falls; and his mother, Mrs. Samuel Klingler, Ashland.

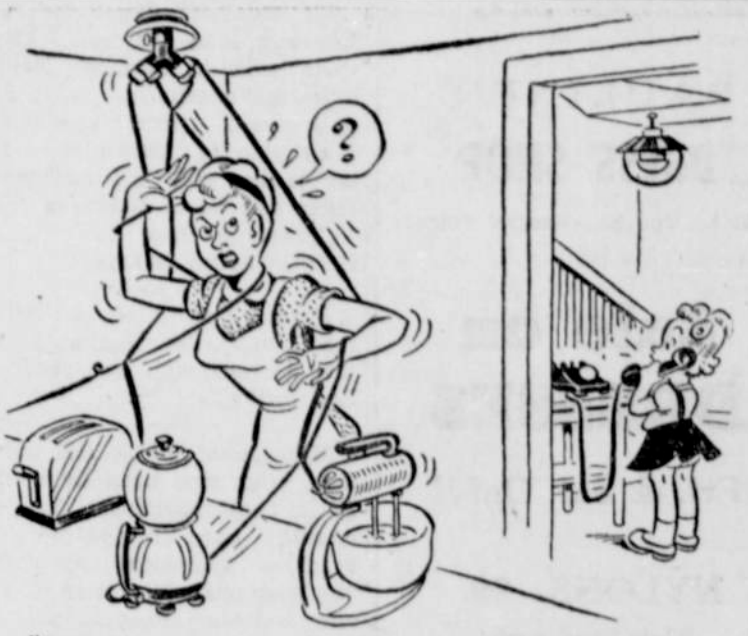
