

March of Dimes A.A.U. Boxing Show To Be Held January 30

The Medford Junior Chamber of Commerce and the Rogue Boxing Club of Medford have teamed up to present a "Show of Champions" for the March of Dimes at Merrick's Arena, Saturday, January 30, in Medford.

Topping the evening will be a double main event. Matched in the first half of this outstanding fistic presentation, Jackie Puscas, the Eugene, Oregon knockout artist, will trade K.O. bombs with San Francisco's left-hooking Jimmy Walker.

For the boxing fans, this stacks up as one of those "ideal" matches where everything is even and its anybody's guess as to who will climb out of the ring the winner—both Walker and Puscas have each boxed in over 80 contests; each man has the power to stop anyone he can hit with a single punch.

Continuing the parade of champions, Ed Millberger, Northwest A.A.U. 146 pound champion will meet Medford's sweet-moving K.O. clouter, Steve Crippen.

In another featured spot on this superb show, Bobby Lyons, Medford, the sweet-moving, hard-socking 110 pounder meets Oregon's A.A.U. flyweight champion from Portland, Lewis Johnson.
