Rural Carrier Arrives, Buys Phillips Home

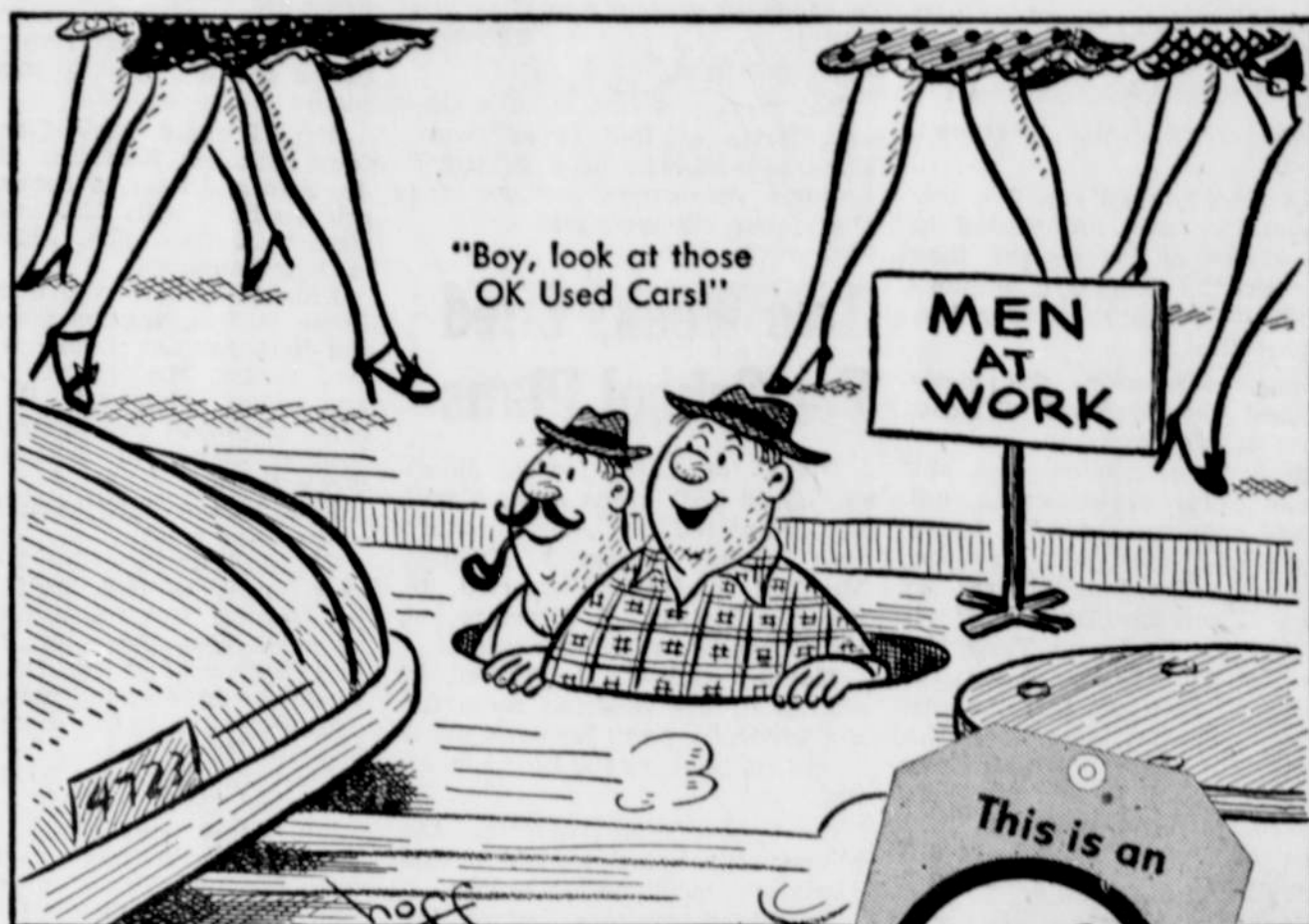
