

THE TIMES TO PUBLISH PAINTINGS AND STORY OF SOUTHERN OREGON ARTISTS IN SERIES STARTING NEXT WEEK

In cooperation with the Southern Oregon Society of Artists, The Times will begin next week publication of a series of 12 paintings selected by the SOSA.

One will be published each week and at the end of that time it is planned to stage an art show in Rogue River.

Besides a photograph of each painting selected, The Times will publish a brief story on each and a brief note on the artist who paints it.

The first four selected by the society are: "Night of the Orient", a black and white by Maxine Titus of Medford.

The artists also select a picture of the month; for March a rural farm scene in oils by Daniel Tesch of Grants Pass.

Tesch, who is 73 years of age, has painted all of his life.

He was born in Germany and was farmed out as an apprentice to an artist.

He lost his hearing in the first World War, and lost three sons in the second World War.

Three years ago he managed to get out of eastern Germany and came to this country.

He can neither read nor speak English but, according to Clifford Platz, president of the SOSA, he is one of the outstanding artists.

Mrs. Cary will give enough instructions so that those attending will be able to start their own rugs from the various materials that they bring.

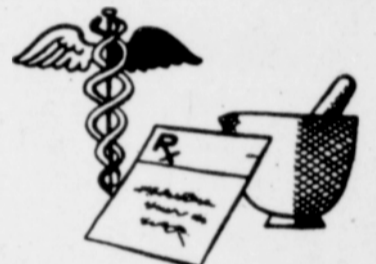
Old jeans make beautiful chenille-like rugs.
