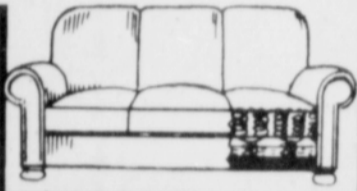

**SAMS VALLEY SCS RE-ELECTS GEORGE LOFTIN SUPERVISOR**

With approximately 90 persons in attendance, the annual meeting of the Sams Valley Soil Conservation District was held in the Sams Valley Grange Hall on Friday, heard reports, and re-elected George Loftin as supervisor, for a 3-year term.

W. B. Tucker, secretary of the board, and Clem Ault, soil conservation service technician, presented reports and plans for 1952, respectively.

The board will pick their chairman at the next regular meeting on March 17th.

Lester Davenport, Conservationist for southwestern Oregon, talked briefly at the meeting on the history of soil conservation program in the United States. He also stressed the responsibilities of the supervisors in administering the program and the soil conservation service for maintaining high technical standards in farm planning and establishing conservation practices on district co operators farms.

Otto Bohnert, member of the State Soil Conservation committee, commended the district on the work they had done and the soundness of the plans they had developed for next year's work.

The regular program was followed by a series of movies. The film "Green Harvest" on tree farming, which highlighted proper timber management, was of interest as was "Alaska Holiday" which was shown along with two "Woody Woodpecker" comedies for the youngsters.

Refreshments were served to the crowd by the women of the Sams Valley PTA.

**FARM LOAN ASSN. REPORTS NEW BUSINESS \$154,000**

The Southern Oregon National Farm Loan Association closed new loans in excess of \$154,000 during 1951.

This was revealed to 110 persons at the annual meeting of stockholders in Gold Hill last week.

A. E. Stevens, president told the increased business and Earl A. Lintz, secretary-treasurer, in his report said stockholders received 4 per cent dividend on capital.

Stevens was elected to a three year term on the board of directors along with Lester Adams of the Applegate area.

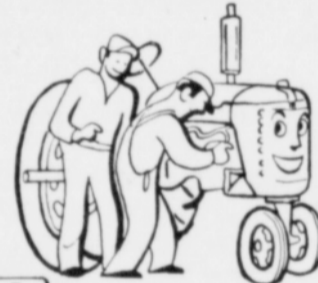
