RECIPE OF THE WEEK
Cream Caramels
(Makes 60)

- 2 cups sugar
- 3/4 cup light corn syrup
- 1/2 cup butter or substitute
- 2 cups cream

Bring slowly to a boil, stirring constantly the sugar, corn syrup, butter and 1 cup of cream. Stir in gradually the remaining cup of cream. Cook until the hard ball stage (254°F.). Pour into a buttered 7-inch square pan, the bottom of which has been covered with 1/2 cup of broken nutmeats, if desired. When cold, cut into squares.
