### Anniversary Weddings.

The silver wedding occurs on the thirty-fifth anniversary. The invitations should be printed in bright silver, with monogram or crest upon both paper and envelope, in silver also. All presents should be of silver.

The close of the fiftieth year of married life brings round the appropriate wedding for the golden wedding. The invitations should be printed on gold paper in gold, with crest or monogram on both paper and envelope in highly burnished gold. The presents offered are also in gold.

Few, indeed, may celebrate their diamond wedding. This should be held on the seventy-fifth anniversary of the wedding day.

It is not required that all guests at such weddings should donate gifts. The donors on such occasions are usually only members of the family or in some cases, the wedding party.
