The Country Ruined.—Twenty Years of Republican Rule Compared with the Democratic Record.

The Democratic party, in the present campaign, are relying for success on the brilliant record of the party, the supposed popularity of their candidate for President, and the alleged short-comings. Of the principles that once made them a great and successful party, were lost sight of when they became the pro-slavery party of the country, and exposed the dangerous doctrines of Calhoun and Jeff Davis. They are now the party of opposition; they live by the alleged errors and abuses of the party in power. To illustrate the strength of this claim, the Washington Republic compares an equal era in the history of the two parties as follows:

In 1860, after twenty years of Democratic rule, a Government six per cent. bond sold for eighty-nine cents. In 1880, after twenty years of Republican rule, a four per cent. bond sells for \$1.08.

In 1860, after twenty years of Democratic rule, a loan of \$18,000,000 exhausted the market for six months. At the end of twenty years Republican rule a loan of \$150,000,000 was taken in a single day.

In twenty years of Republican rule we find: An increase of population of fifty per cent. An increase of general agricultural exports of 600 per cent. An increase in exports of bread and bread-stuffs of 650 per cent. An increase in exports of manufactured articles of 225 per cent. An increase of internal commerce of 700 per cent. An increase of railway mileage of 187 per cent.

In 1860, after twenty years of Democratic rule, Congress authorized a loan of \$25,000,000 to pay current expenses.

In 1880, after twenty years of Republican rule, the Secretary of the Treasury pays \$55,000,000 of debt contracted for a war brought on by the solid Democratic South, which now wants power again to stop the waving of that bloody shirt, the wearing of which is Hancock's chief glory, and his whole available stock as a candidate for the Presidency.

In 1860, after twenty years of Democratic rule, the balance of trade against this country was over \$20,000,000. On May 31st, 1880, after twenty years of Republican rule, the balance of trade was over \$162,000,000 in favor of this country.

In 1860, after twenty years of Democratic rule and teaching, there was very serious question whether we had any Nation, and the old public functionary in the White House, whose chief adviser was Jere Black, the man who now furnishes the statesmanship for Gen. Hancock, announces that there was "no power in the Government to coerce a State," leaving the inference that Jeff Davis and Alex. Stephens could send the country to the demitition bow-wows for all he could do to prevent it. After twenty years of Republican rule there is no doubt that we have a country, and Alex. Stephens and Jere Black would give all they are worth to have the people forget that they ever questioned it.

The kind of ruin which five successive Republican administrations have inflicted upon the country is just a little striking in view of the figures, and the people like it and call for more of the same sort, and are bound to have it, too.

Fictions of the Campaign.

A large share of the stock in trade of Democratic journals, in the present canvass, consists in statements of this and that Republican who "has announced his intention of supporting Hancock." When these statements come to the knowledge of the person whose name is given, he denies the vile imputation, but his denial does not happen to find a place in the columns of the many papers which have published the falsehood. It has been announced that Col. O. H. Irish would support Hancock, but he writes a letter to the Washington "Star" giving a most emphatic and forcible denial to the report; he says:

There has not been an argument used since 1860, in all the time of war or peace, for the support of the nominees of the Republican party, that does not call upon every man, with accumulating and increasing force, to do so now. Not a drop of blood has been shed in defense of the Union, that does not now cry from the ground against those who would now surrender the Govern-

ment into the hands of the party who sought to destroy it.

Because I believe that these men who were so lately arrayed against the Union were honest and in earnest, I cannot trust them under any organization or leadership. Be assured that the cause in which they suffered so much, for which they periled their lives their fortunes and honor, is no less sacred to them now. True, they yielded to superior force; but they will submit to the laws and Government of the Union only until such time as there opportunity through peaceful instrumentalities to secure the objects for which they struggled in the deadly conflict. With these views and keeping in mind the divine injunction not to serve two masters, I shall support Garfield, who in the war and in the peace that followed has served but one party—and that the one which has followed the flag of the Union—rather than Hancock, who has left the side of his compatriots and now seeks to lead those who sought our flag's humiliation.

Hancock's Letter of Acceptance.

A late Washington dispatch says the letter of acceptance of General Hancock has been ready and in print for several days. It is understood to be short. From persons believed to have a general knowledge of its substance, it is gathered that its chief points are as follows: First—That the President's duties are chiefly executive, and that the President must obey the Constitution as the supreme law of the land, and obey and enforce the laws of Congress, whose duty it is to repeal laws when found that they have become obnoxious.

Second—That the political results of the war must be accepted and upheld in good faith, the constitutional amendments and laws enacted in pursuance thereof must be fully respected.

Third—The broadest Democratic ground will be taken on the Chinese question, that Columbia is the home and asylum of the oppressed of all lands, but she will not tolerate enlargement of labor in any form, whether by foreign or local contract.

Fourth—That the duty of the President to make recommendations to Congress is to be pursued in no narrow way, but in a thorough national sense, and as local interests may conflict, the duty of reconciling the matters over which the sections may dispute, belongs to Congress, the law-making power.
