Financing of the Two Parties.

The following table shows the amount of the public moneys of the nation lost by passing through the hands of the Government officials during the various administrations from that of Washington down to and including Hayes: the sum given is that on each \$1000:

From the above which is obtained from a careful examination of the records, it will be seen that with all the talk of Democrats and their journals of official stealing during Republican administrations, the percentage of loss from that source has been much less during the Republican than during the Democratic administrations.

An Infamous trap for Voters.

A few days since the Democrats claimed to have discovered by accident, a letter alleged to have been written by Garfield to a man named Morey, favoring Chinese cheap labor. The signature at first appearance was like that of Garfield, but it was at once pronounced by Garfield to be a forgery. A dispatch of the 23d says that of 50 bankers all but two pronounced it a forgery, on comparison with Garfield's original signature, and the two declined to express an opinion. A detective has traced the forgery to a party named Phelps, who is connected with a Hancock paper mis-called 'The Truth'. A reward has been offered for his conviction, and it will yet be made warm for him. The whole scheme was concocted in the Democratic Central committee to be sprung late in the canvass in the hope of drawing off Garfield's vote among laboring men. The character of the transaction is new understood, and it will only react upon the Democratic managers. No sensible man believes it to be anything else than an infamous fraud.

Who are Voters?

As there is much inquiry as to the qualifications of voters, at the present time, we submit the following as a summary of the law on that subject: Every male citizen of the United States, and every foreign-born male person who shall have declared his intentions to become such citizen one year prior to the election, is entitled to vote, provided he is twenty-one years of age, and has resided in this State six months preceding the election.

Silent.

Why is it that, while Garfield in his letter of acceptance says he is opposed to Chinese immigration, and almost every other public man in the Union has expressed himself on that question, Gen. Hancock has refused and still refuses to say whether he favors Chinese immigration or not? He is looking for Southern support, the Southerners want Chinese laborers--this is the true explanation of his silence.

ALEX. H. STEPHENS, an honest Democrat whose strong common sense and good judgment has more than once pointed out in advance the rock on which the Democracy has split, says of Garfield: He is an honest man, and if the Democrats assail his personal character they will surely elect him. They have done so--they have made the campaign on his personal character, and they have ignominiously failed.

SOME Democrat whose instinctive meanness could find vent in no other manner has been going around the county mutilating Republican posters.
