A Railroad to Coos Bay.

The citizens of Roseburg seem to be in earnest about a railroad between that place and the splendid harbor of Coos bay.

An enthusiastic meeting of the citizens was held to-night, crowding the courthouse. T. R. Sheridan, a leading citizen, was chosen chairman, with S. F. Flood as secretary.

Few of the citizens of this county estimate the importance of such an enterprise. It involves not only a market for the products of this coast, but the establishment of varied industries and enterprises which will build up the material prosperity of the bay.

The building of such a road would open the way for extensive enterprises in the tanning of leather. The bark of these coast counties is unrivaled for such a purpose.

We have woods unrivaled in excellence and beauty for the manufacture of furniture. The myrtle could be utilized here and ought to win for itself a place in the manufactures of this state.

Portland has heretofore enjoyed a large income from the manufacture of sash, doors, and blinds, made out of wood vastly inferior to the cedar of the bay.

The encouragement for such a road is not to be found alone in the material we may have to export. There is no reason why the bulk of the grain of the Willamette valley should not pass out of this harbor.
