He supplies the purchaser with prepared matches, which are put into boxes, but are not liable to change in the atmosphere, and also with a piece of fine ginss paper folded in two. Even a strong blow will not inflame the matches, because of the softness' of the wood underweath, nor does rubbing upon wood or any common substance produce any effect except that of spoiling the match. But when one is pinched between the folds of the glass paper and suddenly drawn out it is instantly inflamed. Mr. Walker does not make them for extensive sale, but only to supply the small de-mand in his own neighborhood."—Newcastle (England) Chronicle.
