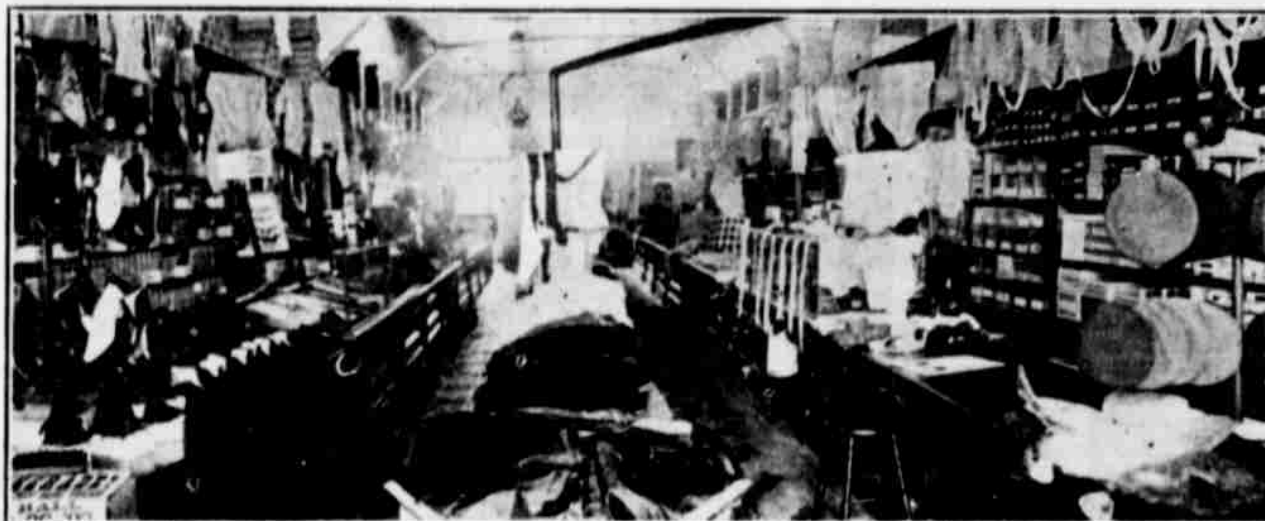


UCH is the department store conducted by Mr. Charles George, who is one of the most enterprising and pushing citizens of the Coos Bay district. Mr. George devotes his person-

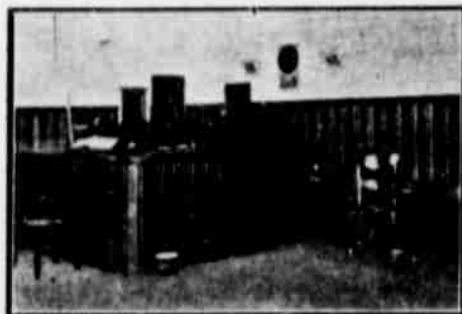

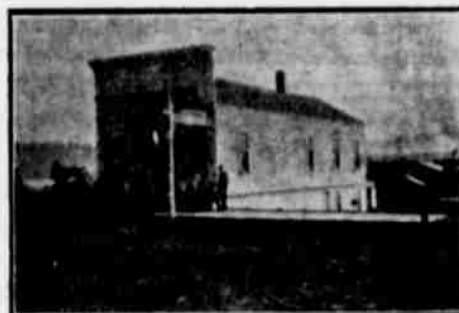
