HOW ED WHITE MET HIS DEATH

Wounded Through the Body by Deputy Sheriff, Shoots Himself.

In a desperate encounter Ed White the ennviet who recently encaped' trom the Oregon penitentiary, was kille near Eddyville Feb, 4th. Atter receir ing a shot through the body from Wincheater rifle in the hande of Deputy Sherifl Robert Warnock. White turned bis 44 -caliber Colt's revolver to hie own forebead and sent a ball into his brain He died five minutes afterward.
The encounter happenel in the vicinity of Robert Warnock'; house. Alter the encounter Sanday, White crossed Aleen Bay to Lutjons and traveled north and east. Monday ojght he spent in a barn owned by Charles Bruner, and Tuesday wa, eeen in the Chitwood Schoolhouse, from which he wat driven by pertens who were going there to hold a meeting. From there he went castbraikfast at a farmboase, Hi Wheresbouts had tecoma known to (fficers, ta ) they were in parsuit. Wedneedsy he paseel down the Yequina Eiver to the vie:nity of the Warnock form. There while passing ap the railroad track with 8 setion Foreman Hewit on a handcar. Robert Warnock obeerref a man answering White's deacription on the county road. When he noticed the handear, and its occupants the convet proceeded to secrete himsel! in the brush near. The handear pasted on a distance of 150 yards beyond Wbjte, when Warnock alighted and raturned to the place where the 'onviet had disappeared. Within a lew minutes white was diecovernd moving along in the lane leading past Warrock's bosse. The house was only about 90 yarde distant from the aonvict's late hiding place, and shores was tied to the fence in front. Warnock at once ordered the convic! halt andjthrow up his hands. White tarned quickly and presented his revolyer as if to shoot. Warnock at onee leyeled his Wincheater, and, without fring hle revolver, White tarnedd an ran the first borse. Warnock opesed are inducing the fogitive to halt, White however, ran to the hore and lost per eral seconde in untying the anima Then he attempted to mount, when ball 'Yrom the officer's rifle pasem tily changing his plan, left the borse and atarted to rua to the barn near the Warnock hoase. He had gone bat a shor distance when a ball from the Winchester stopped bis fil ght. It entered the small of the back, and White staggere this potitiot he placed the muzie of 1 revolver ngal
