Torrens Land Bill.

Following is the substance of the Torrens land bill, the enactment of which was secured by Senator Kelly of Albany:

The bill makes all recorders of deeds registrars of titles in their respective counties, and provides that the owner of any estate or interest in land, whether legal or equitable, may apply to have his title registered.

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF Oregon, you are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint of the above named plaintiff in the above entitled court now on file with the clerk of said court on or before the date prescribed in the order for publication of summons upon you, to-wit: on or before Monday, the first day of April, 1901, the same being more than six weeks from the date of the first publication of said summons.

And you are hereby notified that if you fail to appear and answer said complaint, as hereby required, the plaintiff will apply to the court for the relief prayed for in its complaint, to-wit: For a judgment against defendants W S Wallace and L B Knox as administrators of the estate of R Jane Wallace for \$250 with interest from Oct. 4, 1899, at 8 per cent per annum and \$40 attorneys fees and costs and disbursements and for a decree of said court foreclosing one certain mortgage described in said complaint and directing that the real property described therein to-wit:

Beginning at a point 11.43 chains North of the North boundary line of the Edward Abbott Donation Land Claim No. 1192 and Claim No. 50 in Tr 11 S R 2 West of the Will.
