Notice to Shippers.

In accordance with instructions of L. R. Fields, superintendent, duly approved by M. J. Buckley, General Superintendent, So. Pac. Co., the Car Service Rules of the Pacific Northwest Car Service Association become effective June 1st, 1906.

These rules apply on car load shipments, and provide for the assessment and collection Car Service, (Demurrage), charges when there is failure on part of Consignors or Consignees to load and unload cars within a reasonable time following arrival of cars at station for the purpose of loading or unloading.
