### OBITUARY.

America Price, daughter of Thomas Froman and Elizabeth Round and wife of Nimrod Price was born in the state of Indiana on March 12, 1827, and was eighty-one years, seven months and eighteen days old at the time of her death. She went with her parents to Vermillion County, Illinois, when a young child and was reared near Danville. There she was married to Nimrod Price on October 22, 1846.

In March, 1851 she started from Danville, Illinois, with her husband and two infant sons on the long journey across the plains to Oregon. They reached the Williamette Valley on the 9th of September, and Linn County in October following. On March 22, 1852, they moved upon their Donation Land Claim, in 1854 begun the erection of the house in which she died. Although she with her family spent many years in Albany this house has always been maintained and a portion of each year at least spent in it. For the last twenty-five years it has been her continuous home, and for many years her husband who survives her at the age of Eighty-six and their son and daughter Mr. and Mrs. G. C. Price made their home together.

She reared a large family of sons and daughters of whom seven survive. They are W. K. Price of Tolo, Jackson Co., R. S. Price of Prineville, T. B. Price of Crook, G. C. Price of Albany and Mrs. C. E. Wolverson of Portland, Mrs. C. F. LaFollette, of Highland, California, and Mrs. H. A. Powell, of Clearmont, California.

She was a woman of strong character, thoughtful, helpful and charitable. She had long been a member of the First Presbyterian church of Albany.
