Oregon Factories.

The report of Labor Commissioner Hoff shows the ratio of 272new plants against \$7 standing idle. Throughout Or-egon there are 1743 plants and of these

egon there are 1743 plants and of these 87 are new idle. The 272 new plants employ over three times as many men as those idle, and the great majority of idle plants will start in operation soen. While the October panic of 1907 figured in a small way to bring about the idle condition. Labor Commissioner Hoff gives his opinion that the dispute over lumber rates is the real cause. The state labor commissioner's report follows:

"During the 16 months (June 1, 1907 to September 30, 1908) that the factory law has been in operation, 4222 inspect ions have been made in 1743 plants. Of this number of plants, since the first inspection have been made, 16 have been burned, 2 were destroyed by boiler explosions, 64 have gone out of business, 87 are lying idle, and 272 new plants found operating, nearly all of which belong to the lumber industry.
