Phosphate baking powder is made from burning bones, gathered at slaughter houses whether from diseased animals or not. It is then mixed with a solution of oil of vitriol.

Such baking powder usually contains more or less alum and sells for 25 cents per pound.

Manufacturers of inferior baking powders never print the ingredients on their label, never state how much alum or phosphate it contains; in fact the stronger it is, the more liable it is to be injurious to health.

Be on the safe side and protect your health by demanding the pure cream of tartar kind, which is made from the purest grapes.
