THE PIER WENT DOWN.

The pier in the bridge at Jefferson, went out during last night, that is went out during last night, that is toppled over, due to the high water in the Santiam, and the fact that it was built late in the season, and had not had time to thoroughly settle, the foundation lardly being secure on account of a slight slant. This pier was 32 by 14 at the bottom, 27 by 6 at the top and about forty f et high. It contains 435 yards of cement, one of the largest cement piers in the valley. This means that the bridge will either have to be abandoned during the winter, or used at some risk. It is owned jointly by Linn and Marion, counties, being looked after by the two counties jointly.
