Makes Some Rates.

SALEM, Jan. 29.—The railroad commission on its own volition has established rates on potatoes and vegetables, also reduced rates on grain and flour, which is between three and six cents. In mixed or straight carloads vegetables will be: Portland to Salem one cent, Albany three, Lebanon six, Eugene eight, Oakland eight, Roseburg seven, Ashland and Grants Pass five cents.

**A LIVE AUTO LAW.**

Massachusetts has a good automobile law.

The most important provision of the law imposes a penalty of \$200 fine and six months in prison for racing on the highway or running an automobile recklessly, or attempting to escape after injuring a person. Another stringent provision is imprisonment of one or two years for anyone detected running an automobile while under the influence of intoxicating liquor. The law also forbids the running of a motor vehicle by anyone under 18 years of age.
