TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

A Booming Town.
ELLENSBURG, Jan. 12.—Continued mild weather has enabled builders to prosecute work into midwinter, and there is no cessation of building or outdoor work. Three planing mills in the city are now running constantly to supply orders ahead for spring and summer work, and the sawmills of Puget sound are receiving large orders from Ellensburg. Yesterday one contractor made arrangement for two car loads of lumber a day for six months. This is independent of the lumber supply by local mills.

A County Seat Fight.
TOPEKA, Jan. 12.—Governor Martin received a dispatch this afternoon from the mayor of Cimarron, stating that a force of men from Ingalls, in the same county, had attempted to remove by force the records of the county from Cimarron to the temporary county seat, and that a fight occurred in which several men were killed. Governor Martin immediately ordered General Murray Meyers, of the Second regiment of Kansas militia, at Wichita, to proceed at once to the scene with a company of troops.

Herders Killed.
ST. JOHN'S, A. T., Jan. 13.—A party of men just arrived from the southwest section of this county report three Mexican employes in charge of the sheep of Pedro Mantana killed. Three others are missing. The murdered men were shot while eating breakfast. One of them was in the fire when discovered. The perpetrators of the crime are unknown. The sheriff of the county, accompanied by the party, started immediately for the scene of the crime. The sheriff offers a reward of \$500 for the capture of the murderers.

Lots of Beets.
ANAHEIM, Cal. Jan. 13.—At the meeting of citizens, held here yesterday, to take action in the matter of planting a sufficient acreage of beets to insure the erection of a sugar factory by Claus Spreckelr, to cost half a million and with a monthly pay roll of \$70,000. Representatives were present from Fullerton, Fairview, Placentia, Santa Ana and the entire valley. Great enthusiasm was manifested. It was decided to enter into 10,000 acres can be set out to beets in this vicinity as soon as satisfactory operations are inaugurated.

Woman Suffrage.
WASHINGTON, Jan. 13.—Senator Culom has presented a petition to the senate, which was referred to the committee on territories, from the citizens of Washington territory, praying that when congress passes the enabling acts for the admission of the several territories, they will permit women to vote for delegates to the constitutional convention and on the adoption of the constitution in all the territories, where the legislature have passed a law providing that women may vote, and such law has not been repealed by subsequent legislation.
