## TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

**A Ship Wreck.**  
NEW YORK, April 12.—News of the abandonment in mid ocean of the steamer Denmark was received here by the Maritime Exchange. She is said to have had 650 passengers on board, mostly Scandinavians. Funk, Edge & Co., agents of the company here, at first placed no reliance on the dispatch, but cabled the agents at London and Copenhagen for further particulars.

**Appointments.**  
WASHINGTON, April 12.—The president has made the following appointments:  
Lyman E. Knapp, of Middlebury, Vt., to be governor of Alaska.  
B. M. Read, jr., of Washington territory, to be register of the land office at Seattle.  
The secretary of the treasury to-day appointed John T. Scott superintendent of public buildings at Port Townsend, W. T.

**The Hull Sold.**  
SAN FRANCISCO, April 12.—The wreck of the steamer Yaquina Bay was sold at auction to-day at the Merchants Exchange. Bids commenced at \$250, offered by T. P. H. Whitelaw, and the hull was finally sold to that gentleman for \$800. Mr. Whitelaw said he had to buy the wreck to protect himself.

**Gave Bonds.**  
PORT TOWNSEND, April 12.—Herbert F. Beecher and William Harned, the indicted customs officials, filed \$5000 bonds to-day. Their trials were set for next October. Harned's bondsmen are James Jones and Frank and Albrit Bartlett. Beecher's sureties are F. W. Pettygrove, C. W. Hunt, James Jones and R. K. Lalmer. The latter three were on the grand jury who indicted them.

**A Big Race.**  
SAN FRANCISCO, April 12.—Next Thanksgiving day has been settled on as the day on which the \$20,000 race will be run at Fresno. The entrance fee is \$2000. Several entries have been promised, and it is known definitely that two horses have been entered. One belongs to an Australian banker, while the other will be entered by a local sport on behalf of an Englishman now residing on the coast.

**A Policy.**  
WASHINGTON, April 12.—It is probable that a policy will soon be adopted by the Indian bureau which will stop appointments, as Indian agents, of men residing in the states or territories wherein the reservations are located. It is claimed that experience with home appointments of this kind, especially in Oregon and the Northwest, has been very disastrous to the service, the agents invariably favoring friends and neighbors, and making the interests of the Indians secondary to those of the whites.
