A dispatch from Butte, Montana, says: Reports from Anaconda, Deer Lodge and Missoula show that they all went democratic, while Helena, Bozeman and Great Falls went Republican. Sixty per cent. of the vote lies west of the Rocky Mountain range. Yesterday's election is conceded by the most conservative Republicans to mean two United States Senators and a Representative for the Democracy. Mr. Clark, the candidate for Delegate to Congress last Fall, and Marcus Daly, manager of the Great Anaconda Works, labored for the Democrats. In Butte City the Republicans elected two Aldermen out of seven, the Democrats electing the Mayor, Treasurer, City Attorney and the rest of the Democratic ticket. Anaconda, which went Republican by 750 last Fall now goes democratic by 650. Butte went Republican last Fall by 1,500; it is now Democratic by 386, as is Missoula by 500. The Democrats evidently have combined to carry the new State of Montana.

**That Big Train.**  
SPOKANE FALLS, W. T., April 16.—The agricultural machinery train of twenty-six cars, from Massillon, O., for Russell & Co., of Portland, arrived here at 3 o'clock this morning and remained until 10. It is in charge of Richard Johnson, who was met here by W. C. McMillen traveling salesman for the house. After passing Chippewa Falls the train was run in two sections on passenger time, when in motion. The freight value of the goods is \$80,000 and the freight charges \$9000.

**An Ocean Race.**  
ASTORIA, April 16.—The British ships Fiery Cross and Hornby Castle sailed for Queens town this afternoon. Before leaving Captain Gray, of the former, and Captain Smith, of the latter, each made a wager of \$500 that his vessel would reach the destination first.

**Several In Albany.**  
MENLO PARK, Cal., April 16.—Senator Stanford, in speaking to-day of the progress of the Leland Stanford, Jr., University, said: "I hope to have it ready for opening by the fall of 1890. I have been looking for a man of good business and executive ability, as well as scholarship, for the presidency of the institution. I have not settled on any one as yet, but, if I cannot combine those two qualifications, I will get a business man or take the presidency myself."

**Getting Ready.**  
ST. LOUIS, Mo., April 16.—The latest news from the border is to the effect that the troops are being withdrawn from the neighborhood of Caldwell and other points on the Kansas line, and the boomers are rapidly getting ready to cross the Cherokee outlet to the northern boundary of Oklahoma proper. Then they will go along on the old cattle trails and will reach the border the latter part of this week and be ready to rush across the line on the 22d.

Mann has been appointed postmaster at Hobsonville, Tillamook county, Or., in place of J. E. Sibley, who has resigned.
