TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

Frightful R.R. Accident.

HAMILTON, Ont., April 28.—A terrible railroad accident occurred on the Grand Trunk line near here at 7 o'clock this morning. The St. Louis express jumped the track and the engine ran into the water tank. Two cars were derailed and immediately took fire. All the dead, seventeen in number, have been taken out. The only body identified is that of R. S. Gurney, of Chicago. He was not burned. Another man, name unknown, was also instantly killed. The other fifteen were burned beyond the possibility of identification. About twenty persons were injured, but only one or two seriously. None of the train hands were killed. The fireman was slightly burned and received a bad scalp wound.

Terrible Storm.

SAN FRANCISCO, April 28.—The bark C. D. Bryant arrived this afternoon from Honolulu after a long and tempestuous voyage of twenty days. Captain Lee reports that soon after leaving Honolulu a storm arose. The gale increased in violence. One by one all the sails were blown out of their bolt ropes, and for twenty eight hours the bark was hove under bare poles. At times the wind would rise into a perfect hurricane. Finally oil was cast upon the waves and the waters were somewhat calmed. About this time the storm moderated to a steady gale which lasted three days. Considerable damage besides the loss of the sails was done.

Hayti News.

NEW YORK, April 28.—The U. S. steamer Atlanta arrived to-day from Hayti to take part in the naval parade. She left Cape Haytien April 21. The United States consul at Gonaves is authority for the statement that Hippolyte had cut the army of Legation in two and had one section of it in a position where it was being reduced by starvation. He considers the speedy surrender of Legation extremely probable.

Will be Lots of It.

SAN FRANCISCO, April 28.—E. E. Rice, an employe of Wells, Fargo & Co., residing in this city, has in his possession a piece of the original coffin which encased the remains of George Washington. It is of dark color, porous and of light weight. The body had been buried thirty six years when the old coffin was broken up and the remains interred at Mount Vernon.

A Sand Storm.

ARLINGTON, Or., April 28.—A sand storm has been blowing along the river between here and the Dalles since yesterday noon, and since last night the railroad track has been blocked near Wallace. Three passenger trains are lying between Blalocks and Des Chutes. The blockade will be raised as soon as the wind subsides.
