WALLA WALLA, W. T., May 1.—On Tuesday at Centerville, Or., Wils Coyle, a notorious sport, won \$80 at poker from Thomas Hart and Ben Anderson. Coyle caught them cheating and remonstrated, whereupon the latter drew revolvers, one of them firing, the ball grazing Coyle's cheek. Immediately they made Coyle give up the money won, and they ran out, took their buggy, which was hitched near by, and escaped to this city. The men were arrested in this city after a desperate resistance.

PORT TOWNSEND, W. T., May 1.—Frank McKee, brother of President Harrison's son-in-law, has been appointed deputy collector, vice Walter Bowen. William F. Learned has been appointed inspector, vice Thomas Delaney.  
**A Good Month.**  
ASTORIA, Or., May 1.—For the first time in many years no fatal accidents have occurred among the fishing fleet in April below Tongue Point. The rainfall here in April was 5.59 inches. The mean temperature last month was 52.6 degrees.  
**A Combination.**  
OTTAWA, Ont., May 1.—The Canadian Pacific, St. Paul & Minnesota and Manitoba roads are about forming a strong combination. Hill of the latter road, will go into the directory of the Canadian Pacific at a meeting to be held next week, while Sir George Stephens and Sir Donald Smith will become directors of the St. Paul road. The Western business will go to Vancouver, B. C., via Winnipeg, while the East bound business will be handled via Sault Ste Marie, this arrangement being made as a result of the aggressive policy of the Northern Pacific.

**Caused Excitement.**  
SAN FRANCISCO, May 1.—During the centennial exercise at the pavilion last evening, while Frank M. Pixley was delivering the oration, a scene of confusion occurred that almost terminated in a free fight between the American and foreign population present. In the course of his oration Pixley used the sentence "foreign immigration is becoming the curse of the nation." At that place he was interrupted by a loud burst of applause from several hundred persons congregated in one spot at the rear of the hall. Long did the noise continue, and Mayor Pond's appeals for decorum were in vain.
