

BUSY MANHATTAN ISLAND.

It is doubtful if there is a busier spot in the world of the same size than Manhattan Island. With the year ending with September the elevated railroads of New York city carried more than 170,eco,coo passengers. And that is a passenger traffic only four and a half million less than the whole traffic of the German empire for the same time, with its 18,000 miles of roads! In France, where there is more travel, the record is 205,273,340 passengers carried ever her 20,144 miles of road, which is about 15 per cent more than went up and down in New York and wandered to and fro in it during the same time. In this country during the same time there were carried 428,225,513 passengers over the 149,912 miles of road; but in this were included the 170,000,000 of New York's intramural record. So it appears that this traffic was about 40 per cent of the traffic of the whole country, and it was carried on 321/2 miles of track,
