SEATTLE, May 15 .- The returns of yesterday's election are by no means complete but enough is known to warrant the statement that the constitutional convention will be s fely republican. It is estimated here that there will be forty four republicans to thirty one democrats in the convention

TPORTLAND, Or., May 15 .- The suit of W H Watkinds against the Southern Pacific railroad company for damages came up this morning, and the court denies the motion for judgement on the pleading and want of reply. Watkinds claims he was precipitated to the ground at the town of Leban n, while attempting to get aboard a train belonging to the defendant, by reason of a short turn in the sidewalk, at which place there was no light, and he sustained several broken ribs and loss of valuable time
