BE READY FOR THE INSECT PESTS.
Fruit culture requires intelligence and vigilance, eternal vigilance. There are so many insects continually preying upon fruits, that it is only by vigilance that it can be made profitable. If the insects that fatten upon your fruits can be destroyed and the fruit remain intact, it pays. One of the worst enemies to fruit growing is the borer, but it is easily kept in check, if you take it in time. Take a long, sharp pointed wire, and push it into the orifice where he is imbedded, and it will wind him up. The next is the old-fashioned caterpillar, and I have found that the best and cheapest way to destroy him is to give him a dose of Paris green or London purple. Just spray that on your trees, and when the caterpillar takes his breakfast, he gets the poison and is gone. The next is the canker worm; this is the worm that defoliates your trees, making them look as though scorched; Paris green or London purple is the remedy. Next, the codlin moth is a terrible enemy to fruit, but we have a remedy. Put sheep or hogs in your orchards where they eat up the little apples that contain the embryo worm or spray the trees with London purple or Paris green. It is a demonstrated fact that the use of these will save over 90 per cent of the fruit; but there should be some concert of action among fruit growers to make this a perfect success.—Seth Fenner in New England Home-Stead.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

The First Wheat.
SAN FRANCISCO, May 24.—A carload of this year's wheat arrived to-day from Reelley, Fresno county. It was purchased at \$1 37 1/2 per cental. Last year the first consignment was received here June 15, and brought \$1 31 1/2 per cental. Never before has wheat been received at this point in May and indications therefore point to an early harvest. The stock of old wheat in this state will be taken June 1. It is thought there will be little new wheat offered before July.

Jury Disagreed.
WALLA WALLA, May 24.—The jury in the case of James Gordon Cooper, charged with the murder of Thomas Davis, last November below the city, was unable to agree, and were discharged this morning, four being for and eight against conviction. The sentiment of the community is favorable to the prisoner.

Moving Northwest.
HELENA, Mont., May 24.—During the last fortnight a considerable number of emigrants have been passing through Montana, en route to the British possessions, traveling by wagon. It has been ascertained that they are Mormons from Utah and Idaho, and that their destination is the country through which the Galt railway passes.

Famous Woman Dead.
BOSTON, May 24.—Laura Bridgman, deaf, dumb and blind from two years of age, made widely famous by Charles Dickens in his "Famous Notes," and also by many public references to her wonderful intelligence, died to-day at the South Boston asylum, where she had long dwelt, aged 60 years.

A Clue.
CHICAGO, May 24.—It was learned to-day that the police had struck quite an important clue in the Cronin mystery. It seems beyond doubt that they have discovered the place where Cronin was murdered, a vacant cottage in Lakeview.

Nicaragua Canal.
NEW YORK, May 24.—The Nicaragua Canal Company has announced that the steamer ship Alvena, to sail for Greytown, Nicaragua, at noon May 25, will carry about fifty men and a quantity of implements and stores for the Nicaragua Canal Construction Company, being the pioneer expedition for the commencement of the work of building the Nicaragua inter-oceanic canal. Similar consignments of men and materials for the prosecution of work will follow one another at short intervals.
