

It would be difficult to conceive of a sentence or paragraph published in a newspaper at which some one would not rise up and complain. No doubt if we should speak of our apothecary stores in Albany as drachm shops, the proprietors with one accord would rise up and without scruple as to their correct department- or without making a grain of allowance for the correct use of language, would attempt to pound us into jelley, so with our usual discretion we omi to say it.

INDEPENDENCE, Or., May 28 .- Thomas Hogan, who lately came here from San Francisco, last flight, broke into Alex Davis's room at the City hotel and stole therefrom one suit of clothes and a revolver, all valued at \$25. He immediately skipped but was caught at Eola to-day by Marshal Wayne Williams and was brought back and lodged in jail here. He was given an examination this afternoon before Justice Butler and was bound over to appear before the grand jury in the sum of \$500.
