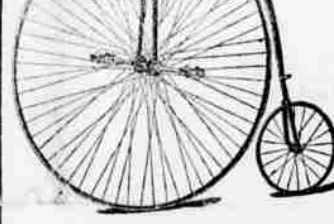

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

A Cyclone.

McPHERSON, Kas., May 29.—A cyclone formed about six miles southwest of this city yesterday afternoon, passing almost directly east through the country, and striking the earth three times in its passage. Where it struck everything was destroyed.

Three miles east of Elyria it struck John Nightingale's house, taking it from its foundation with all its contents and carrying it entirely away, not a vestige of it having been seen since. The family escaped by taking refuge in the cellar. B Katzap's house was also destroyed, and the family were likewise saved by taking refuge in the cellar.

Montana Democratic.

HELENA, Mont., May 29.—The announcement was made to-day of the official count for one of the Helena districts, which has been delayed for some reason. It settles the question as to the democratic majority in the constitutional convention. The democrats have been claiming five, but the returns to-day elected Gillette, republican, which cuts it down to four. The totals stand: Democrats, 39; republicans 35; labor 1.

Wanted Office Bad.

WASHINGTON, May 28.—A man named H. G Dodge, of Bar Harbor, Maine, while waiting in Halford's room for a chance to see the president to-day, was taken sick and fell to the floor in a faint. Assistance was rendered him, and when sufficiently recovered he was removed to his rooms. It is understood that he left a sick bed to go to the White House, and that when informed that the president was too much engaged to grant him interview to-day the shock was so great that he fell in a fit.

Big Pension.

WASHINGTON, May 29.—A certificate for a pension was to-day granted to Philip Flood, formerly a private in company E of the Forty-second Ohio volunteer infantry. The amount of arrears allowed by the pension office in his case is \$15,289, his disability dating back to November 14, 1862. This is the largest first payment on record in the pension office.

WASHINGTON, May 29.—The president has appointed John B Cotton, of Lewiston, Me., assistant attorney general, vice Robert A Howard, of Arkansas, resigned.

Val A Milroy Postmaster at Olympia, W. T., vice Arthur D Glover, removed.
 The president has appointed Orlow W Chapman, of New York, solicitor general.
 Secretary Noble to-day appointed Lorenzo D Montgomery, of Oregon, special agent on the Indian depletion claims at \$8 per day.
