SEATTLE, June 12.—Two bundred men were put to work by the city to day, upon recoommendation of the general relief committee. They were placed under charge of Colonel Haines, of the First regiment, and will be engaged on the streets in cleaning brick, etc. They will be paid \$2 per day and will be charged 15 cents for every meal taken at the

They would have held a meeting, but only five or six were present, and so they decided to postpone it until evening; but only seven could be found who could be pursuaded to assemble, so the evening meeting was postponed until to-morrow.
