TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

Seattle. SEATTLE, June 12.—Two hundred men were put to work by the city to day, upon recommendation of the general relief committee.

The saloon keepers of the city thought they would hold a mass meeting to-day, to protest against the action of the authorities in shutting up the saloons. They would have held a meeting, but only five or six were present, and so they decided to postpone it until evening; but only seven could be found who could be persuaded to assemble.

The burnt district presents a scene of great activity. Hundreds of men are at work all along the water front rebuilding wharves. The Oregon Improvement Company expects to have its coal bunkers ready for the shipment of coal within three weeks.

JOHNSON, JOHNSTOWN, June 12.—Order is coming out of chaos, and the military discipline has shown its effects at the end of the first day.

The bureau of registration reported to-day that 15,678 survivors had registered. Many registered twice, and some half a dozen times, which caused the list to run up to 21,000.

To-day scarcely twenty names were registered, showing that the work is approaching completion. The number of bodies recovered here is 1192, of which 643 have been identified.

NEW YORK, June 12.—The corridors of the Fifth Avenue hotel were crowded to-day with prominent democrats. The democratic national committee meets at noon to choose a successor to W H Barnum.

On motion of Judge McKenny, of Kentucky seconded by Senator Gorman, of Maryland, Calvin S. Brice was then unanimously chosen chairman.

Terrible Wreck in Ireland. DUBLIN, June 12.—An excursion train from Arrmahagh was wrecked near that place to-day. The train contained 1250 persons, composing a Methodist Sunday school, including scholars, teachers and relatives.

Seventy bodies have been taken from the wreck, and others are buried under the debris. Over 100 were injured.
