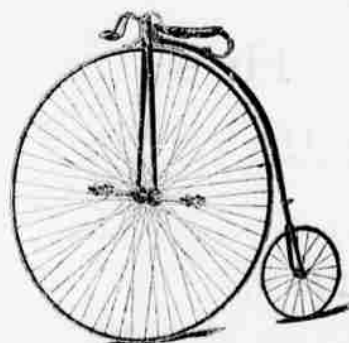

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS

A Stage Accident.

SPOKANE FALLS, June 19.—A stage coach was upset to-day at Wardner Junction, in the Coeur d'Alenes. The occupants were all severely injured.

Professor Clayton, the well known mining expert, had both his legs crushed at the knee, and it is thought he cannot survive.

Charles Hussey, owner of the Morning mine, was injured about the head and shoulders.

W C Miller, a civil engineer of Wardner, and E J Field, a prominent mining man, were both badly bruised.

The driver's left arm was broken.

The stage was a total wreck.

A Cigarette Did It.

MODESTO, Cal., June 19.—The grain on the land of J S Withersell, near Ceres, caught fire this afternoon. About 300 acres were burned over. One hundred acres on Withersell's land was burned. W L Canfield lost seventy or eighty acres. Levi Carter two stacks cut from 160 acres. All the grain burned was estimated at twenty-five bushels to the acre. The supposed cause of the fire was a cigarette stump.

The Pennsylvania Election.

PHILADELPHIA, June 19.—Official and estimated returns from every county in the state show that the prohibition amendment was defeated by 188,449 majority. The reports from all but twelve counties show a majority of 146,996 against the amendment providing for the repeal of the polltax qualifications.

Change of Stock.

NEW YORK, June 19.—At a conference held to-day between representatives of the O R & N and Union Pacific companies in regard to the future management, an agreement was made with Villard by which about 60,000 shares of O R & N stock will pass into the hands of half a dozen people who are now identified with the Union Pacific and Manitoba companies.

The Reason.

BUTTE, June 19.—Judge De Wolf issued a peremptory order to-day to the medical board to grant a certificate allowing Dr McLaren to practice medicine until the board meets in October. McLaren represents the Liebig dispensary in this city, and is a graduate in medicine of McGill university, Montreal, Canada. The only reason that a certificate was refused is that he was connected with an advertising establishment.
