Rhode Island Election.
 PROVIDENCE, June 20.—The fifth amendment to the constitution of Rhode Island—the prohibition amendment—was to-day repealed by a vote of 5499, more than three fifths of the total vote necessary to carry the amendment. The total vote is: Approve, 18,449; reject, 985. In 1886 when the amendment was adopted the vote, which was about 14,000 smaller, stood: Approve, 15,223; reject, 9230. The vote will be officially counted before July 15th, and will be announced by proclamation on or before July 20th.

The R R Com.
 SALEM, Or., June 20.—The supreme court has sustained Secretary of State McBride in his refusal to pay the governor's appointee for railroad commissioner. Following is the decision: W H Biggs, railroad commissioner of the state of Oregon, appellant, vs. George W. McBride, secretary of state of Oregon, respondent, appeal from Marion county; judgment of the lower court affirmed; opinion by Strahan.

Stage Held Up.
 EUREKA, June 20.—The overland stage for Eureka was stopped by two men yesterday morning, three miles south of Bell Springs. The mail pouch was taken by them, cut open and over hauled and then returned to the stage driver. The pouch did not contain any register matter, and only the San Francisco letter packages were taken. No cash was found.

An Immense Fire.
 SHANGHAI, June 20.—One-half of the important city of Lachan, in the province of Szechuen, was recently destroyed by fire. The conflagration raged four days. It is estimated that 1200 persons were killed. Most of them were crushed trying to escape from narrow streets. Ten thousands persons are homeless.

An Earthquake.
 SUSANVILLE, June 20.—About thirty shocks of earthquake were felt last night. There was one very heavy shock. No damage resulted. The earth has been shaking all day from all directions. The flow of water from the springs was increased, the water being turned to a milky color.

Simon Cameron.
 LANCASTER, Pa., June 20.—General Simon Cameron was prostrated to-day at his home, Donegal Springs, with paralysis of the right arm and side. His condition is critical.
