Steamers from China bring news of a shocking disaster in the province of Kiang Su. The city of Su-Chow, situated on the Imperial Canal about 55 miles northwest of Shanghai, is said to have been nearly swept out of existence by fire. Seven out of the eight gates of the city are said to have been destroyed, and the loss of life—burned and trampled to death—is estimated at ten thousand. Su-Chow had, in 1880, a population of 500,000.

Russia is conspicuous among the great nations of the earth for continually increasing her armaments, both on land and sea. At present she is actively extending her naval power in the Black Sea. Besides an addition to her fleet already under way there, she has just ordered three immense iron-clads of 11,000 tons of 12-horse power, with six heavy guns. AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS AT DEYOE & ROBSON

Not only are human beings black or dark in hot climates, but other animals vary in like manner. Pigs are usually black in hot climates. The carbon layer in the skin of the negro, being opaque, like other forms of carbon, must form an effectual veil and thus protect that most important organ below, the true skin; a bodily envelope or tissue presenting a vast surface of circulating blood, which is certainly subject to brilliant illumination when only protected from sunlight by the thin translucent cuticle. Hence as we know that sunlight has considerable chemical energy, and also that sun-stroke, to which light complexioned people are especially liable, is more dependent on light than on mere temperature.

At a recent meeting of the London Meteorological Society, a paper was read on the deaths, caused by lightning in England and Wales from 1852 to 1880, as recorded in the returns of the Registrar-General. It was stated that the total number of deaths from lightning during the twenty-nine years amounted to 546, of which 422 were males and 124 females. It is also stated that in consequence of their greater exposure the inhabitants of rural districts suffer more from lightning than those of towns. It was shown, likewise, that nearness to the west and south coasts reduced the liability to injury by lightning, and that distance from the coast and high land seemed to increase it.

A Duel at Astoria.

They went beyond the cemetery and fought, Boldt knocking out Lucas. Lucas told Boldt he was best that way, and now they would have a contest with knife and pistol. The second duel began by Boldt drawing a pistol and shooting Lucas in the neck. Lucas was taken to the hospital in a very weak condition. Boldt has been arrested.

A Seattle Accident.
SEATTLE, June 27.—One man was killed and another dangerously injured at half past 11 this morning by the falling of the division wall of the San Francisco store and Union block. A number of men were working beneath, and the first warning they had was the cry of a workman that the wall was falling.
