**TELEGRAPHIC NEWS**

Ellensburg Burned.

ELLENSBURG, W. T., July 5.—At 11 P M fire broke out in J S Anthony's grocery on Main street, between Fourth and Fifth, and fanned by a brisk west wind rapidly destroyed the whole business portion of Ellensburg, with exception of the First National bank and the Lynch block, the fire is spreading among the residences in the southeastern part of the city. The streets are crowded with teams and drays, moving goods to places of safety. The water supply is inadequate and there is nothing but a hand engine with which to fight the flames. There have been no fatalities, nor has any one been injured so far as known. About fourteen blocks were destroyed: The loss cannot fall short of \$1,000,000. The burned district is bounded on the east by Sprague street, on the West by Water, and extends from Fifth to Second.

A Texas Storm.

FORT WORTH, Tex., July 3.—Yesterday seven inches of rain had fallen in this part of the state and great damage resulted. Reports from the West show heavy rains for 200 miles. The Brazos and the Trinity are booming. At Brook, west twelve miles, a bridge on the Texas & Pacific and 500 feet of track were washed away. The St. Louis, Arkansas & Texas for two miles is submerged.

A Brakeman Killed.

SEATTLE, July 4.—Charles E Merville, aged 30, a brakeman on the Columbia & Puget Sound railroad, was run over by a car this afternoon at Kent, the wheels passing over his left thigh and right foot. He was brought to Seattle, where his thigh was amputated. After suffering terrible agony he died this evening. He came from Pittsburg recently, and leaves a young wife in this city.

The Road Goes.

ASTORIA, July 4.—Considerable amusement was created in this city this afternoon by the telegraphic headline in the Oregonian, "Astoria Must Wait." Astoria has no intention to wait. She is up and dressed, and sends greeting to her big sister on the Willamette. The road goes.

A Close Game.

LA GRANDE, Or., July 4.—The baseball game of La Grande vs. Arlington ended in a score of 5 to 6. Ten innings were played. The game stood 3 to 3 at the end of the ninth inning. Barker and Garrison, of Portland, played with the Arlingtons.
