Their Salaries.

BISMARCK, Dak., July 17.—The committee
on executive has agreed on its report on the
salaries of the state officers, but will not sub-
mit it to the convention for several days. The
salaries recommended are as follows: Governor,
\$3000; lieutenant governor, \$1000; auditor and
commissioner of insurance, \$2500 each; sec-
retary of state, treasurer, superintendent of public
instruction, commissioner of schools and public
land and attorney general, \$3000 each. The
committee also recommends that the railroad
commission consist of three members, who shall
be elected, and whose salaries shall be \$3000
each.

Served Them Right.

PENNINGTON, July 17.—Nightwatchman
Dutman surprised a number of tramps attempt-
ing to break into a building Monday night. On
his approach they fled. He commanded a halt.
They didn't halt worth a cuss, and he fired
three shots. One shot took effect in the region
of the kidneys in one man who will probably
die. Dutman surrendered to the authorities,
was charged with assault with a dangerous
weapon, and held in the sum of \$1000 for ap-
pearance Monday night. Bail was immedi-
ately furnished and Dutman resumed his duties.

Just a Report.

NEW YORK, July 17.—A report is current in
democratic political circles that a deal has been
made which shelves ex President Cleveland perma-
nently, and places ex Secretary of the Navy
William C. Whitney in the lead as the demo-
cratic presidential candidate for 1892. Last
week there was an influx of democratic leaders
from Ohio to see Colonel Bruce, chairman of
the democratic national committee.

A Bad P. M.

WASHINGTON, July 17.—The civil service
commission to-day made public its second re-
port in the Milwaukee postoffice investigation.
It is very voluminous, and details at length the
substantiation of the charges against Postmaster
Paul, and concludes as follows: Mr. Paul has
grossly and habitually violated the civil service
law and has done it in a peculiarly revolting
and underhanded manner. His conduct merits
the severest punishment. While he retains his
position, it is hopeless to effect an honest ad-
ministration of the laws. His further contin-
uance in office would be a great misfortune, and
we recommend his immediate removal.

The Hawkins Murder Trial.

SALISBURY, July 17.—The Hawkins murder case
was given to the jury this morning, with im-
partial instructions by Judge Boise. The jury
is still deliberating, and the general belief is
that no verdict will be reached. It is rumored
that five are for acquittal, two for murder, and
five for manslaughter.
