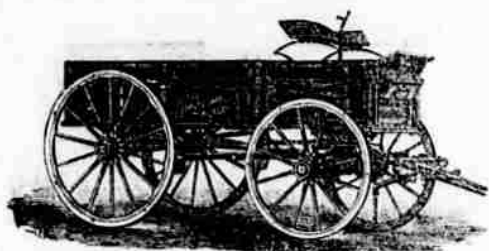


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25 MILES SHORTER. 20 HOURS LESS TIME
