Miss Kate Field has resigned her position as lecturer & special agent for the Cal. Vutscultural Association. She has been severely criticized by religious and temperance people, this she no doubt expected, bu. she is wrathy over what she terms the "outrageous criticism eminating from the private office of the Gover-nor of California." It seems that the Gover-nor objects to the bills she sent in after her Washington "reception," and other entertain ments or wive suppers, such impertenance from the Governor, Miss Field will not submit to, hence she resigns.

Hon Henry B Metcalf in writing on the late vote in Rhode Island says, "I have been asked repeatedly, did not many christian men vote for the repeal of prohibition. I answer the question raised, in the light only of my personal experience, by saying that I have conversed with a considerable number of professed Christians who voted with the liquor sellers on June 20th, not one of whom (omitting those who are moderate drinkers) has given any evidence of actual, specific knowledge of the condition of intemperance in Rhole Island or anywhere else, ander either home or prohibition, or of any desire to acquire such knowledge. They have simply accepted the casy, or the popular or the fashionable side of the question. Prob-ably most of them are invocent of anything that resembles a conviction on this great question among questions.
