**Benjamin Harrison, in his letter of ac-  
ceptance, September 11, 1888, said: "We  
believe it to be one of the worthy objects  
of tariff legislation to preserve the Ameri-  
can market for the American producers,  
and to maintain the American scale of  
wages by adequate discriminating duties  
upon foreign competing products. Less  
work and lower wages must be accepted  
as the inevitable result of the increased  
offerings of foreign goods on our markets."  
As if to furnish the most striking com-  
mentary possible on the superficial na-  
ture of these assertions, it fell out that on  
the very day General Harrison rode  
through Pennsylvania on his way to his  
inauguration, four large manufacturing  
concerns in that state posted notices of a  
reduction of wages. Since that time reduc-  
tions, shut downs, strikes and failures have  
followed in quick succession, leaving thou-  
sands of workmen to inquire what ben-  
efit the republican policy of unnecessary  
duties upon articles of daily consumption  
has been to them.**

**Another Creamery Collapsing.**

UNION, Or., Aug. 14.—The creamery at La  
Grand is in trouble, and will probably suspend.  
The builders, Davis & Rankin, have com-  
menced suit to foreclose the lien and recover the  
balance due for constructing the creamery.  
There are thirty seven defendants.

**Sensible Yakima.**

NORTH YAKIMA, W T., Aug. 14.—The  
city council on Tuesday night purchased a  
Clapp & Jones No 3 steam engine for a new  
fire department, also 3000 feet of No 1 hose,  
and authorized the city marshal to receive bids  
for the construction of five large cisterns, to be  
located centrally in the business portion of the  
city, each with a capacity of 25,000 gallons.

**A Stabbing Case.**

SALEM, Aug. 14.—This morning A W Mize  
cut and stabbed with a pocket knife a young  
man named Matthews, five miles south of the  
city. Matthews and a younger brother became  
involved in a quarrel with Mize, and a fight  
ensued, Matthews knocked him down and  
was choking him. He cried enough, and was  
released, when he drew a pocket knife and  
slashed away. The wounds are not serious.  
Mize has been a prominent school teacher for  
some years. No arrest has yet been made.

SEATTLE, Aug. 14.—Karl Jerner, a turner,  
aged 45, recently from California, committed  
suicide this afternoon in a lodging house by  
taking poison. For some time he had been  
drinking fifty to a hundred glasses of whisky  
daily, and was on the verge of delirium tremens.


