ARE DEMOCRATS ALL MURDERERS.

The Portland Oregonian is nothing if no vindictive. It likes to have men hanged. I rejoice at a conviction "in the first degree," and is always greatly provoked by any respite or reprieve. It delights to revive, when a prominent man dies, if he differed from it politically, all the evil he ever did, and magnify it. According to this organ, but very few good men have ever lived or died in this country; and as for any body who voted the Democratic ticket, why he was a villain, and that is all there is about it.

In its usual spirit, and with its usual vindictiveness, this paper has loaded the name of David S. Terry with a great weight of evil. He was "an exceedingly infamous man," he was a man of an "ungovernable, murderous temper; he 'richly deserved his fate,' etc." It is not our purpose to discuss all this. Terry was not a model man. He had his faults. But after painting him as black as it possibly could, after depicting him as a murderer and as guilty of innumerable crimes, this newspaper says:

"What Terry has been well represents the character and history of the democratic party of the United States."

That is to say, about one half of the people of the United States are murderers, and only to be considered as criminals of the deepest dye, because they are Democrats. This is the logic of the remark. We pity the man whose soul is so full of bitterness and opposition and vindictiveness as to write such a sentence. It shows that his animus is such as to be beneath argument.—East Oregonian.

St. Petersburg women are generally making a pilgrimage to a certain shop, where three dressing gowns are to be seen, which will be the gift of the Czarina to the Princess Alexandra of Greece, who is about to be married to the Grand Duke Paul of Russia. The temptation to drink cold water in excess in the haying or harvest field is lessened by making coffee, or better still, cocoa, as drink for the harvesters. Cocoa has a considerable nutritive value, and though after taking it a drink of water may be wanted, it will be light, and the nutrition previously taken will prevent it from doing any injury. Oatmeal with drinking water is an excellent strengthener in hot weather. We do not call it a tonic, though it has the effect of one, as the word tonic usually means stimulant. Oatmeal in drinking water only stimulates by the nutrition it contains.

Getting Warmer.

SEATTLE, Aug. 19.—The entrance of Judge Hoyt and John R. Kinnear into the King county political fight, the former as a candidate for the United States senate and the latter for governor, has made a great stir and split the party here wide open. The Post-Intelligencer heartily espouses the cause of the new candidates as against Squire and Ferry, and is making a hard fight. Efforts to compromise were made to-day and have utterly failed, and the matter will be fought out in the primaries. It is the hottest fight on record here, and the whole country is divided into angry factions.

Civil Service Examination.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 19.—The civil service examinations for applicants for the railway mail service will be held in the following cities September 3: Tucson, A. T.; San Francisco, Sacramento, Los Angeles, Denver, Pueblo, Boise City, Spokane Falls, Seattle, Miles City, Helena, Carson City, Albuquerque, Portland, Roseburg, Salt Lake City and Cheyenne.

A Pioneer Dead.

INDEPENDENCE, Or., Aug. 19.—Joshua Brown, a wealthy resident of this county, a pioneer of 1852, died at his home, seven miles from here, at 2 o'clock this morning. He leaves an estate worth \$100,000. He leaves two sons here. He came to Oregon from Indiana, where, it is said, he has other children living.

Nine People Burned.

NEW YORK, Aug. 19.—Early this morning a fire broke out in the kitchen of the restaurant of a fifty story tenement at 305 West Seventh avenue. Nine of the sixty odd occupants of the house lost their lives, and it is a great wonder that many more did not perish.
