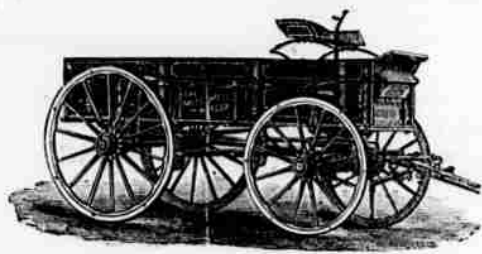


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Arrive Yaquina, 5:30 P. M. Arrive Albany, 11:10 A. M.
